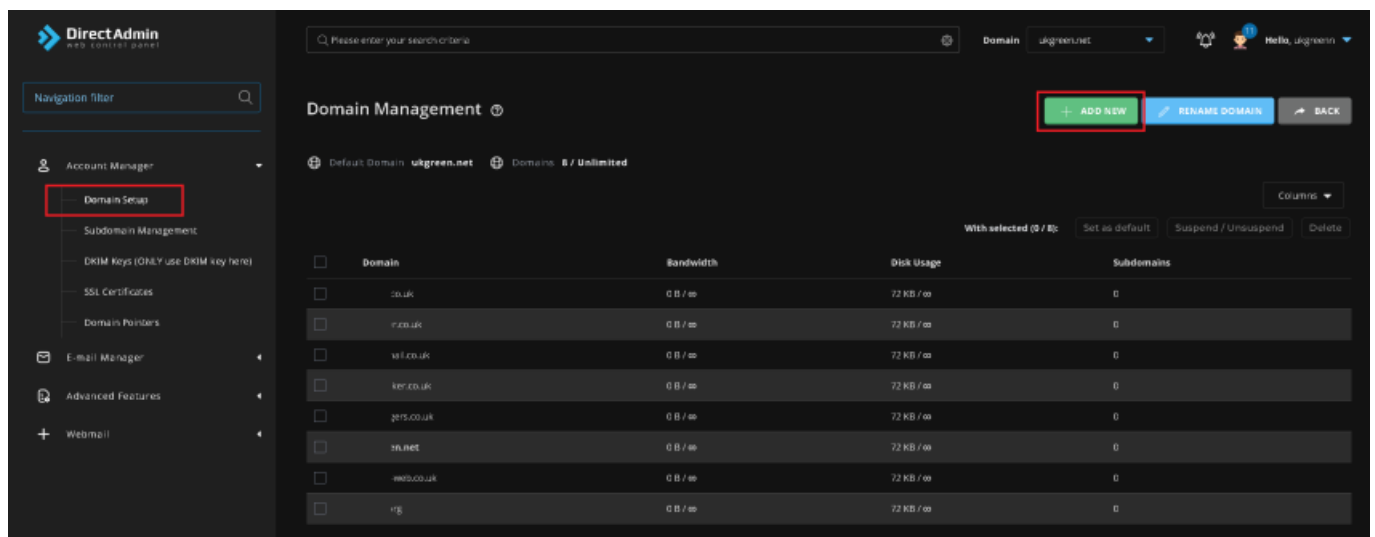

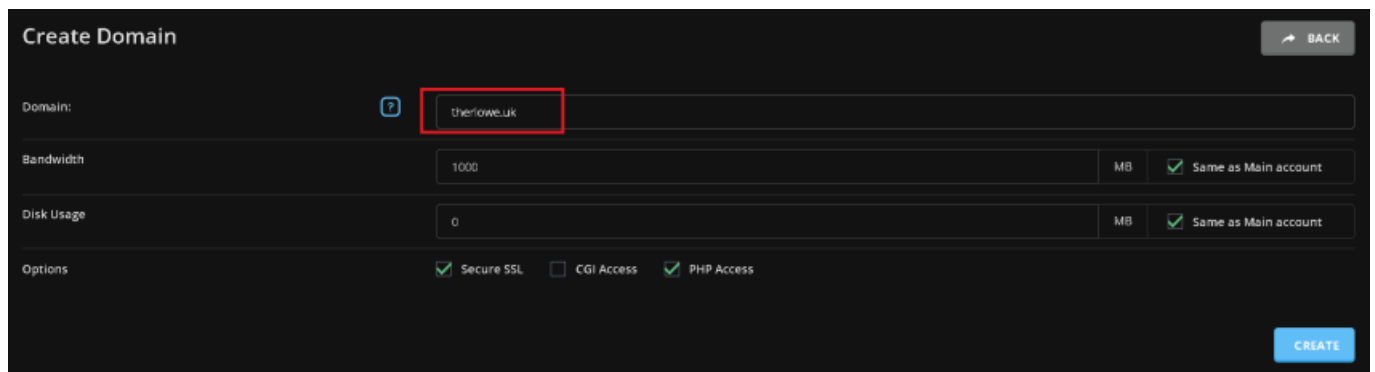
Add Domain
