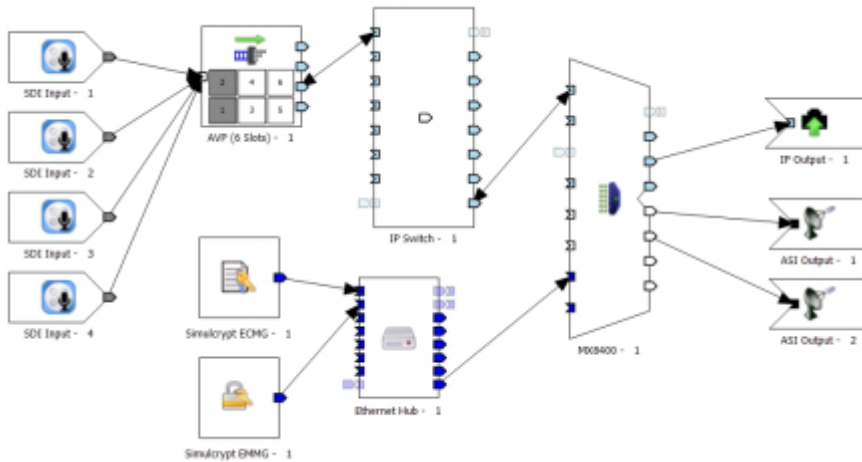


# Cisco VLANs and Trunks (danscourses)
