

Virtual Box

Oracle Virtual Box provides a simple virtualisation environment for testing configurations. Most notably we can use OVB to provide test guest OS environments for MFEL.

However, the networking can be a little tricky. So here is a small guide on getting your VM working on a network.

Network Modes

For network configuration, VirtualBox (5.1) provides the following network modes:

- Not attached“ mode (not connected)
- Network Address Translation (NAT)
- Nat Network
- Bridged networking (network bridge)
- Internal networking (internal network)
- Host-only networking (Host-only adapter)
- Generic

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
